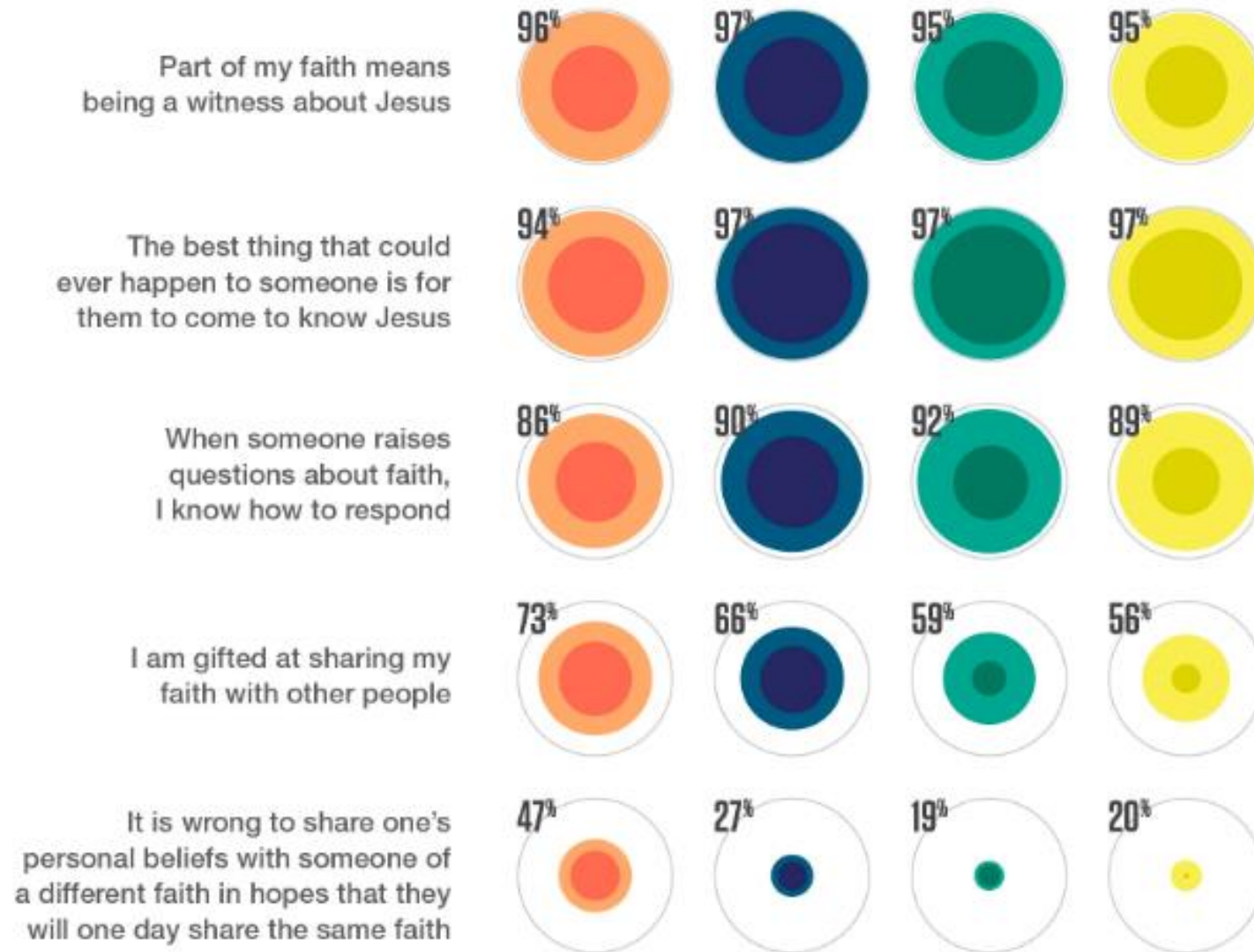
GENERATIONAL DIFFERENCES ON FAITH-SHARING

● Millennials ● Gen X ● Boomers ● Elders

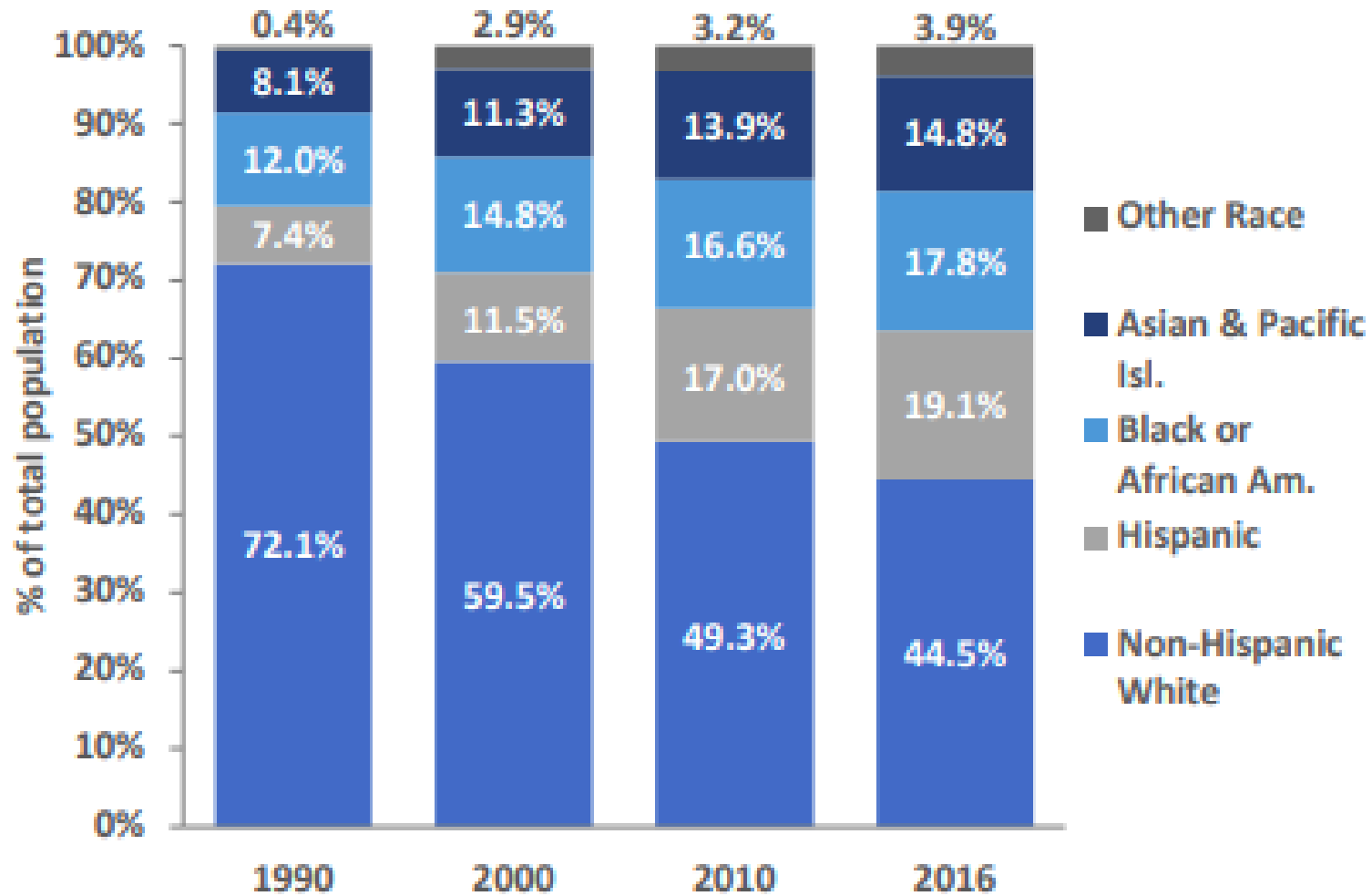

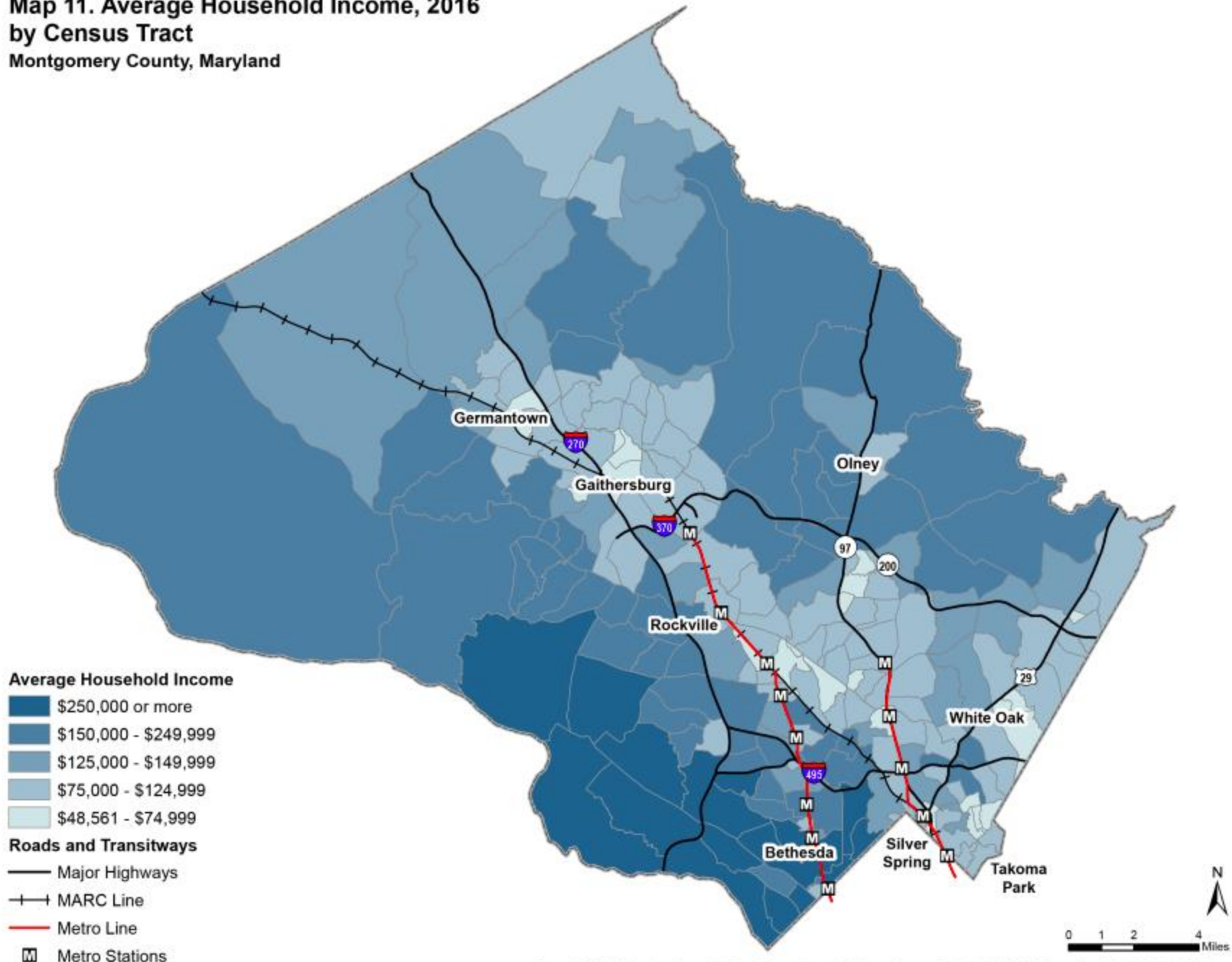

Figure 5. Population by Race and Hispanic Origin, 1990-2016

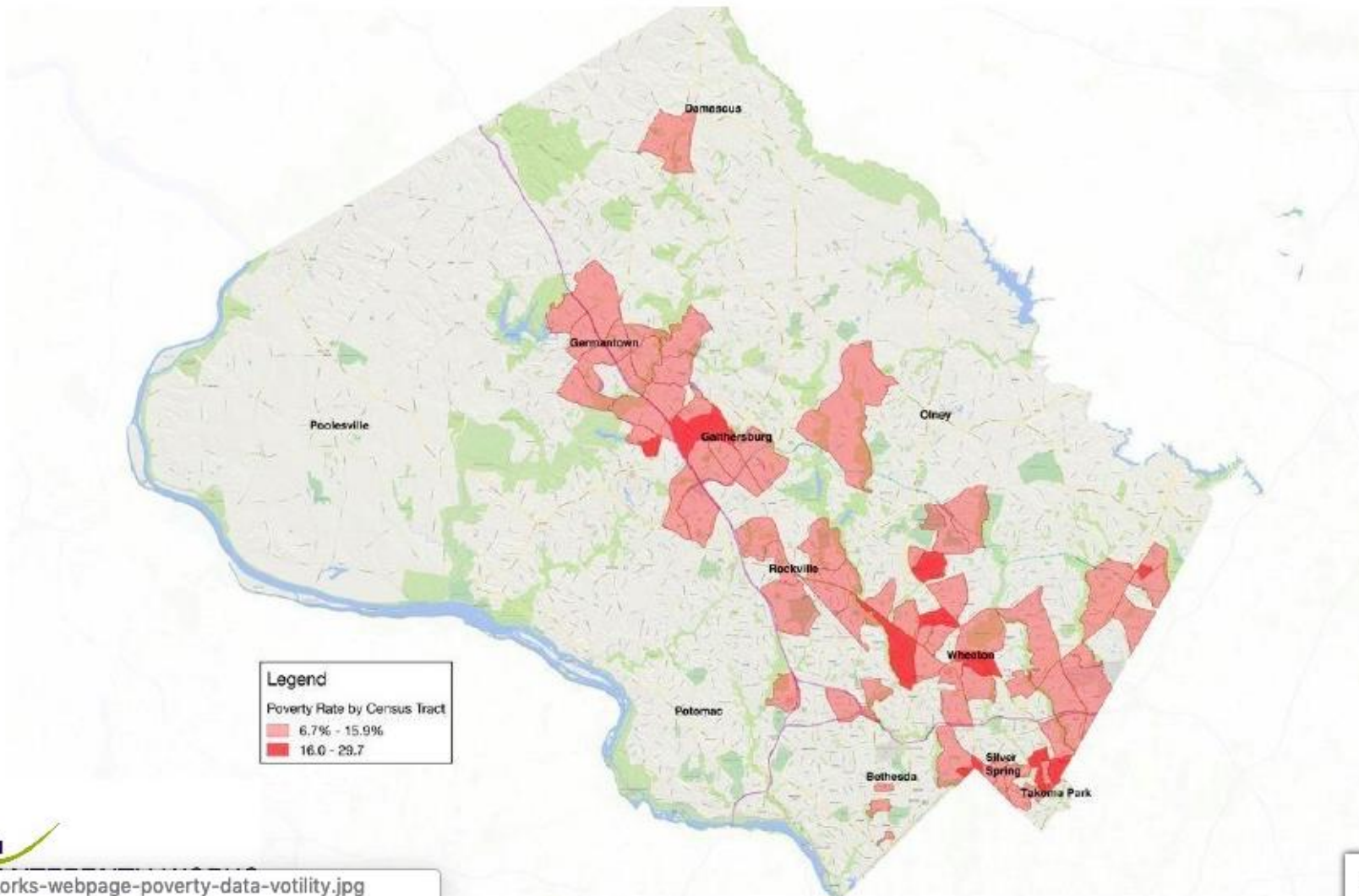


**Map 11. Average Household Income, 2016
